Notice of Non-Discrimination

**SECTION 504 OF THE REHABILITATION ACT
AND THE AMERICANS WITH DISABILITIES ACT**

Section 504 of the Rehabilitation Act of 1973 (“Section 504”) and the Americans with Disabilities Act (“ADA”) prohibit discrimination against individuals with disabilities in any program receiving federal financial assistance. Persons protected under Section 504 and the ADA include students, applicants, and members in the community who come within the definitions of “individual with a disability.” Under section 504 and the ADA, the definition of an ‘individual with a disability’ is a person who has a physical or mental impairment that substantially limits one or more major life activities.

The Jefferson County Public School District is committed to ensuring compliance with Section 504 and the ADA. Accordingly, no discrimination against any persons with a disability shall knowingly be permitted in any program or practice in the District. The District further acknowledges that it has the responsibility to provide adjustments, modifications, and necessary services to eligible students or individuals with disabilities.
