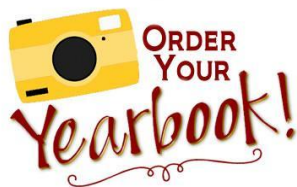

Arvada West and Ralston Valley High School at Lincoln

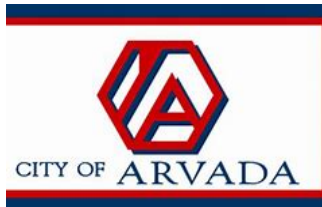
Monday, February 12, at 8:00 am

72nd Ave Construction Update



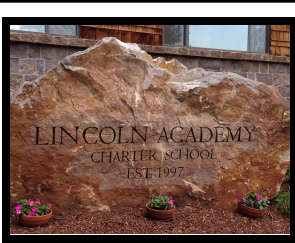
Road Construction Update from the City of Arvada

The speed limit on W 72nd Avenue is 25 mph, corridor-wide. Please obey the posted speed limit signs when traveling through the active construction zone.

Simms to Oak streets:

- Traffic remains open in both directions on W 72nd Avenue. However, travel lanes may shift from day to day as specific construction locations change through the end of this phase of the project in Spring 2024.
 - Motorists should expect various intermittent lane closures on W 72nd Avenue.
- Crews will be striping the roadway, backfilling medians, installing railing, signs and traffic signals on W 72nd Avenue for several weeks.
- A closure of W 72nd Avenue, from Swadley Court to Simms Street is tentatively scheduled for as early as Monday, Feb. 5, for approximately one week, weather pending. Please use Simms Street to W 64th Avenue to Ward Road for alternate access. Stay tuned for additional information.
 - This closure is required for crews to excavate, backfill, place road base and asphalt pavement on the roadway. This work will tie in the new W 72nd Avenue on this end of the corridor into the existing W 72nd Avenue.
- Utility companies will be on-site and will continue work east of Oak to Kipling streets for the foreseeable future —weather and supply chain-dependent.
- The City of Arvada and our contractor periodically fly drones above W 72nd Avenue to record progress of the project. Videos are available to view at the [City's YouTube webpage](#)
