


If your child is sick, we ask that you keep your child at home and call the Lincoln Academy attendance line. You will need to leave your child's first and last name as well as the reason for their absence, including any symptoms of illness. If your child or any member of your household has tested positive for COVID-19, alll siblings must stay home unless the siblings are fully vaccinated. If you have questions about testing, please contact the front office at 303-467-5363, extension 0.

ISOLATION AND QUARANTINE PROTOCOLS

DISTRICT PROTOGOL



POSITIVE COVID TEST &/OR COVID SYMPTOMATIC

ISOLATE FOR 5 DAYS MINIMUM

- Stay home for 5 days.
- Return to school/work on day 6 - as long as there is no fever for at least 24 hours without using medication and no symptoms.
- No test is required to return.

EXPOSED TO COVID: UNVACCINATED

QUARANTINE FOR 5 DAYS MINIMUM

- Stay home for 5 days.
- Return to school/work on day 6 - as long as there is no fever for at least 24 hours without using medication and no symptoms have been developed since exposure.
- No test is required to return.
- Note: this also applies for schools in "outbreak status".

EXPOSED TO COVID: VACCINATED

NO QUARANTINE

• Attend school/work.

NTHER HEIPEILL INFO

- Anyone three years and older must wear a mask at all times while inside the school buildings.
- At this time, Lincoln Academy will **not** be requiring students to submit vaccination status. If a particular student is identified as a close contact to a COVID positive individual, the school and/or <u>Jefferson County Department of Health (JCPH)</u> may request vaccination status at that time.
- All staff are required to provide proof of COVID-19 vaccination or weekly negative test results.
- To increase viral mitigation efforts, Lincoln Academy will continue to exceed the cleaning and disinfecting guidelines from the CDC. Lincoln Academy has also increased fresh-air flow rates and air filtration in all buildings.
