2017-2018

First Round Choice Enrollment ends Tuesday, January 31.



Current Lincoln families who wish to enroll their kindergarten student for the fall of 2017 *must* turn in a First Round Choice Enrollment form by January 31 in order to ensure placement in the kindergarten program for next year.

Documents to provide along with the Choice Enrollment Application:

- Birth certificate for children entering grade K and first
- For families of children who do not have siblings currently enrolled in our K-8 program, please submit a recent utility bill with a parent name and address listed
- If your child is not already a Jeffco student, please add him/her to your <u>Jeffco Connect</u> account
- Offers for kindergarten class placement (AM, PM or Full day) for siblings of students currently attending Lincoln Academy will be made when the Choice Enrollment Application is submitted.
- Applications are available via this link <u>Lincoln</u>
 <u>Academy.net/Enrollment</u> and in the front
 office.
- If you have a student currently enrolled in grades K-8, you do not need to submit this application. Your student(s) will remain enrolled at Lincoln next year.
