If you prefer to opt out of releasing directory information you will have three opt out options. Please choose these options carefully. Opting out of 'Jeffco Publications' will mean your child will not be included in our yearbook. The link above explains the choices in detail. You may choose not to release information by checking the appropriate boxes for each child within 30 calendar days of the first day of school.

- Review and sign the Jeffco Student and Family Handbook (Code of Conduct). It is very important you review this document to understand your rights and responsibilities.
- Review and sign the 'Bring Your Own Device' policy.
- Submit Your 2018-19 Digital Signature
  - Once each tab on the left side of the screen has been reviewed click the 'Submit' tab at the top of the 'Summary' page to submit your digital signature for the 2018-19 school year.
- Bookmark the JeffcoConnect link, or make note of where you can find it from LincolnAcademy.net.

After school begins, remember to keep your contact information up-to-date in JeffcoConnect so that the school can contact you regarding emergencies, attendance and general school activities.
